THINK and FEEL

- Dan is proud that he has helped bringing his company success in the real estate industry
- Family (wife and 5 sons) is extremely important
- He feels that he put a lot of time and money into programs that should help make the lives of his agents and employees easier

SEE

- Dan sees the hard work his employees put into their job
- He sees the potential that some employees have in creating useful methods to help complete their job
- Dan notices how the drone operator does not have time for a personal life because of his busy work schedule

HEAR

- Dan listens to the struggles of family life and work-life as two of his real estate agents are battling a difficult home life
- He hears the passion of how and why some of his employees became real estate agents, auctioneers, and marketing/drone, specialist

SAY and DO

- Dan is not a licensed real estate agent, nor does he want to be. He only wants to focus on being the CEO
- Dan acts silly on all four jobs and it comes off as unprofessional to those he is shadowing
- He's behavior changes as he starts to open up to a real estate agent

PAIN

- Dan is empathetic to his agent's struggles of battling cancer and caring for a disabled child
- He is afraid the programs purchased are not helping his company

GAIN

- Dan Duffy hopes to gain a better understanding of how his employees and real estate agents feel about the programs he has for them. He wants to make sure that the content and design allow each person flush in their specific field. More specifically Dan wants his question "How is it working for you?" To be answered.
- Dan looks at succeeds by seeing how well someone's time is managed. He wants everyone to be able to have an equal balance of family and work.

The Agent - Brenda

During Dan's fourth and final job as Simon, he went to Austin. Texas, to work with a licensed real estate agent, Brenda to learn how to stage a home. Dan was extremely excited as well as Brenda to be working together on the house. After completing the staging Dan and Brenda had the most noticeable empathetic moment. Brenda was wearing a pink ribbon as a necklace, which represents Brest cancer. Two years before filming she was diagnosed and opted out of chemotherapy for the holistic route of treatment. This type can only be done outside of the states and is the main reason she moved from California to Texas.

- Brenda is a confident and intense woman

PAIN

- Brenda's pain comes from having to stay so far away from her son
- She works extremely hard every day, both physically and mentally

GAIN

- Brenda hopes to help inspiring and established agents as well as home buyers
- Brenda wants to get better as soon as she can so she can be closer to her son
